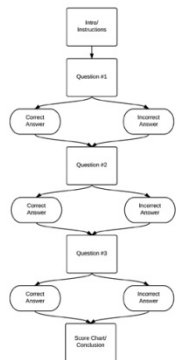
# MOVEMENTS IN ART QUIZ

**Overview:** This quiz consists of three questions to test students on their retention of information distributed during an art history lesson.



Here is the diagram or flowchart of this interactive quiz.\* (a larger version is included below)

**Description:** This flowchart moves in a linear fashion with the exception of divergent paths for the answers for each question. Ultimately, no matter what path is chosen, the final landing spot of the conclusion remains the same.
